Apply for Our Youth Philanthropy Fellowship

We've re-envisioned our fellowship role to accommodate busy schedules with a focus on advising YPC strategy and professional development! The fellow(s) will provide insights to the Director and Leadership Team in the overall strategy of Youth Philanthropy Connect partnering with several other fellows for a period of one year. For 2-5 hours a month (excluding business travel opportunities), s/he will work remotely using his/her computer to gain professional development experience through fireside chats with key sector leaders, provide direction to YPC, and act as a spokesperson for YPC at various events throughout the year.
